Getting into the School

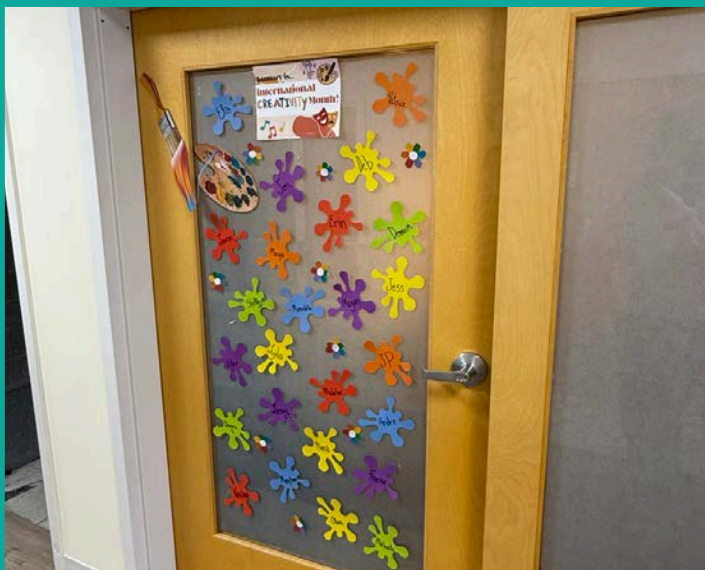


If the second set of doors is locked or if you need assistance, you can always ring the doorbell on the wall and one of our SOTA educators will come greet you at the door.

The Hallway



When I enter the building, I will walk through one long hallway. The hallway is bright and easy to follow.



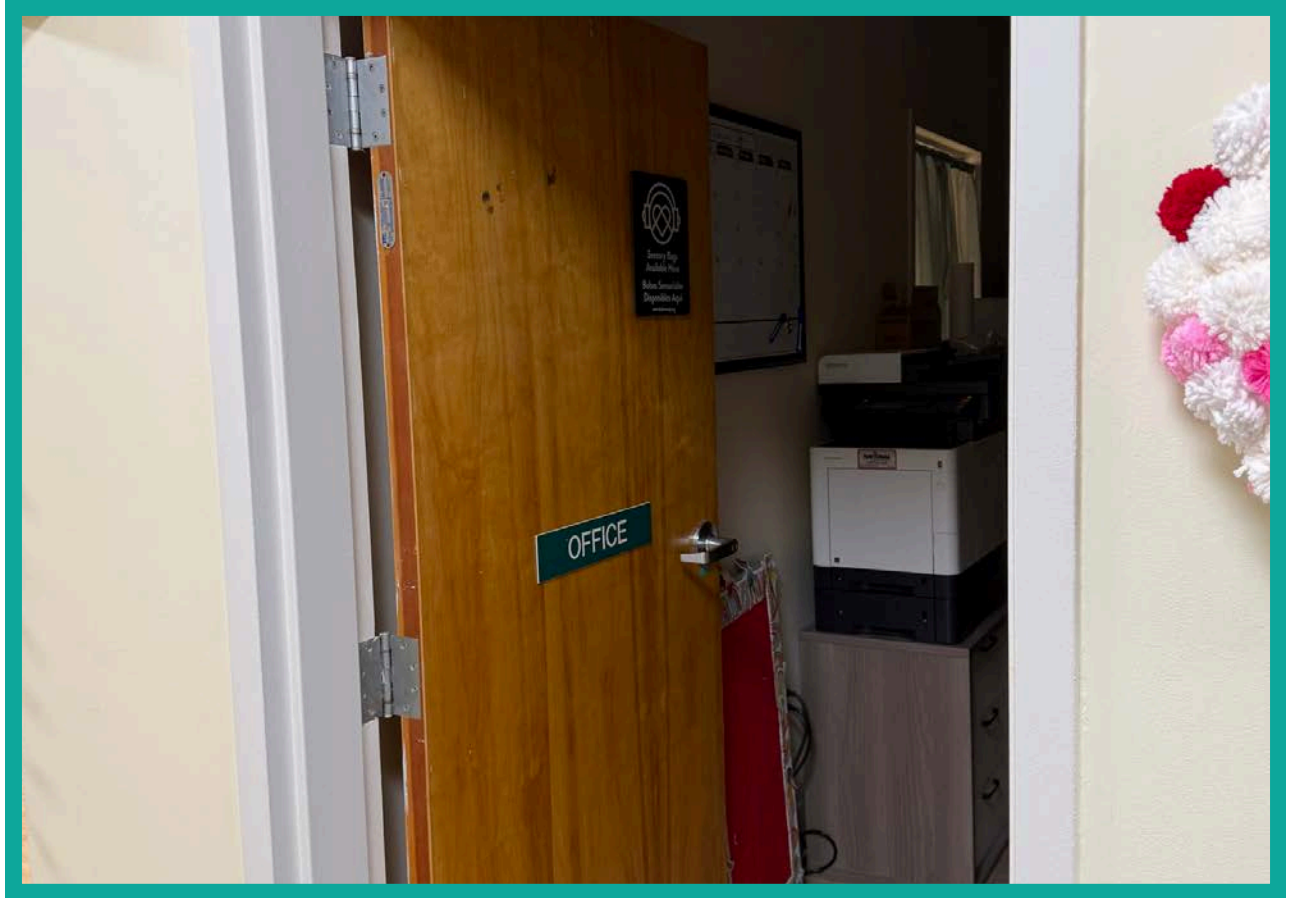
I may see staff members working in their offices or walking through the hallway. They are happy to help if I need anything.

Water Station



As you move down the hallway, there is a water bottle fill station on the right. If you forget to bring a water bottle, we always have cups for you to use to get a drink.

Supply Office



Just past the water fill station is our supply office.

Studio 1



Studio 1 is where we host most of our music classes. There is a big piano in the corner. As you continue down the hallway, the entrances to all three studios are on your left.

Studio 2



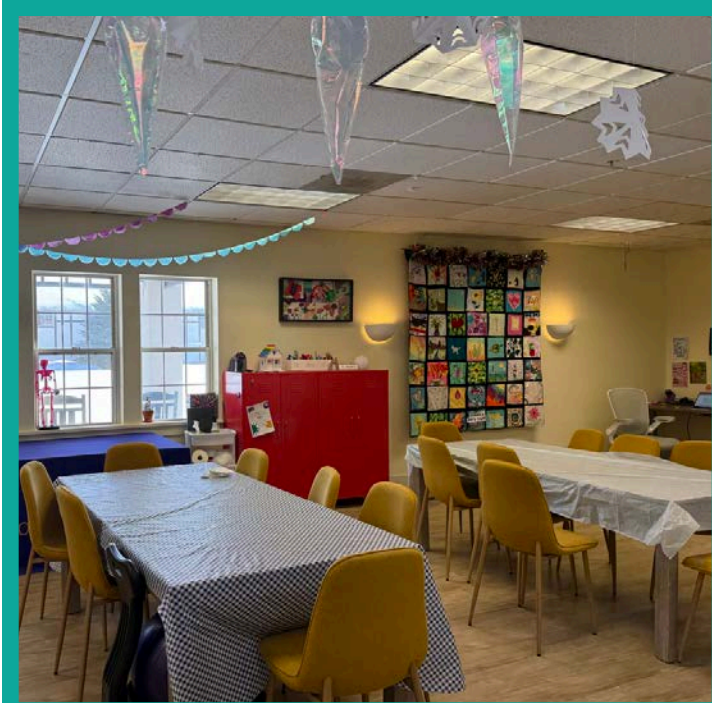
Studio 2 is where we host most of our dance classes. Sometimes, a theatre class might meet in Studio 2 even though the wall outside says “DANCE.”

Studio 3



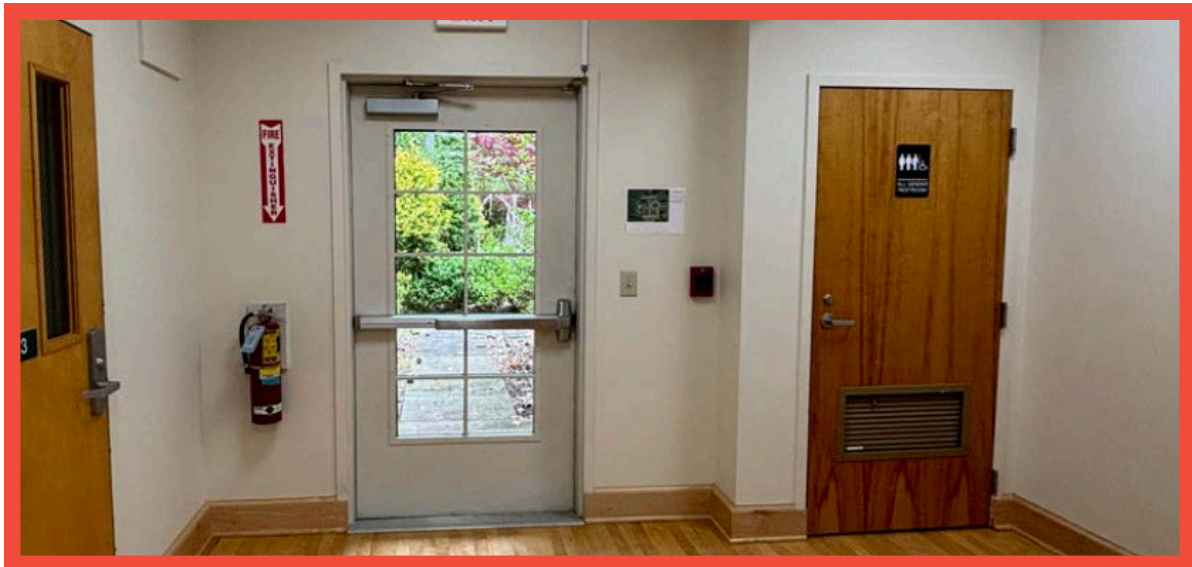
Studio 3 is where we host most of our theatre classes. Sometimes, a dance class might meet in Studio 3 even though the wall outside says “THEATRE.”

Common Area



In the middle of the building there is a common area with tables and chairs. There is also a small library of children's books, puzzles, and toys.

Restrooms



Restrooms are located at the end of the hallway across from Studio 3. An accessible restroom is located farther down the hallway near the back entrance.

Sensory Room



Next to the bathrooms across from Studio 3 is our Sensory Room. This is a designated quiet space with tools that can help you feel calm. It is available if you need a break.

If you have any questions while at SPAC School of the Arts, you can talk to a friendly staff member. They wear a round, purple badge that says, “HERE TO HELP.” Sometimes, staff members wear “SPAC Education” t-shirts.



They can also get you a KultureCity® Sensory Bag. Inside a KultureCity® Sensory Bag are items you can use to feel calm while at school. You can use the headphones in areas that are too loud. You can use the fidget tools to keep yourself focused.
